Go outside and look for the following items. When you find them, read the Scripture passage and reflect on what God's word has to say!

ROCK: The Lord is my rock and my fortress and my savior, My God, my rock, in whom I take refuge. Psalm 18:2



BRANCH: In those days and at that time I will make a righteous Branch of David sprout; and He shall execute justice and righteousness on the earth. Jeremiah 33: 15

SOIL: The one sown with seed on the good soil, this is the one who hears the word and understands it, who indeed bears fruit. Matthew 13:18



SEEDS: The kingdom of heaven is like a mustard seed, which a person took and sowed in his field; and this is smaller than all the other seeds, but when it is fully grown, it is larger than the garden plants and becomes a tree, so that the birds of the sky come and nest in its branches. Mt. 13:31



LEAF: He will be like a tree planted by streams of water, Which yields its fruit in its season, And its leaf does not wither; And in whatever he does, he prospers. Psalm 1:3



FLOWER: The grass withers, the flower fades, But the word of our God stands forever. Isaiah 40:8



THORN: The seed which fell among the thorns, these are the ones who have heard, and as they go on their way they are choked with worries and riches and pleasures of this life, and bring no fruit to maturity. Lk. 8: 14

BIRDS: Look at the birds of the air, that they do not sow, nor reap nor gather into barns, and yet your heavenly Father feeds them. Are you not worth much more than they? Mt. 6:26



WATER: Whoever drinks of the water that I will give him shall never thirst; but the water that I will give him will become in him a well of water springing up to eternal life. Jn. 4:14




SUN: From the rising of the sun to its setting The name of the Lord is to be praised. Psalm 113:3
